

UVCEGA SCHOLARSHIPS 2021-22

UVCE Graduates Association has started awarding Scholarships starting this year. Taking up the initiative which was under the banner of VisionUVCE for the past 10 years, UVCEGA is very glad to continue this noble cause.

Providing Scholarships is aimed at supporting the students in need and also to motivate them to reach higher and push themselves to achieve their dreams. We hope that the scholarship awarded will help the student in boosting the confidence up and we expect that it is put to the best possible use. We hope that the student performs well in his/her curricular and co-curricular activities and brings accolades to his/her alma mater and to his/her near and dear ones.



This year, we had received around 250+ applications from the students, out of which around 120 of them were shortlisted for interviews. Over the course of two weekends, around 25 alumni participated actively in this online interaction with the students and understood their needs and requirements and evaluated them accordingly. The final list of students was tabulated accordingly. You can check the list in the inside pages. An overview of the Scholarships is:

- 15 Laptops (worth of around 25K each)
- 20 Full Scholarships (worth of 15K each)
- 35 Half Scholarships (worth of 10K each)

For the current year, a total budget of 10.25 Lakhs is planned for the Scholarships initiative. In the Budget proposed for UVCEGA FY 2021-22 during the previous AGM, it was planned as 5Lakhs. So, we are thankful to the alumni for the support and showing us that when there is a need, there is no dearth of helping hands. We appreciate every alumni contribution irrespective of whether it is large or small. It is the mindset to “Give Back to UVCE” that we respect. The complete list of donors and appreciations will be updated in our website shortly.

We will be having a Scholarships Distribution Ceremony on Wednesday 27th April, 2022 at UVCE Quadrangle. Since it is a week day and we are aware that the alumni would like to talk with the students, we will also have an Online interaction event with the students after that. The details of the same will be announced shortly.

UVCE FOUNDATION SUPPORT TO EEE LAB

As mentioned previously in one of our Sampada editions, UVCE Foundation had helped in getting a MoU signed with Schneider Electric with the college to setup a R&D Lab for Power Electronics (Electrical Department) and assured financial support as well (during 2020-21)

Recently, UVCE Foundation has procured **10kW variable Power Supply** which is worth of around 4.15Lakhs and handed it over to the Electrical Department. To setup the lab, Bangalore University has already procured Power meters, Current Probe, Digital Multimeter worth of around 5 Lakhs. Once all the required setup is done, Schneider Electric will be providing UPS Systems for testing, measurement and modification (technology transfer). This will be one of the unique R&D Lab centres at UVCE and help to nurture the research eco-system in the college.

UVCE Graduates Association applauds this gesture from UVCE Foundation and hope that more alumni will come forward to “Give Back to UVCE” in different ways.

UVCEGA IN PRESS

- UVCE Graduates Association's aim is to revitalize alumni network and play active part in making UVCE reach new heights.
- UVCE Graduates Association focus on building a strong alumni community

The news was covered by various important & leading newspapers—Times Of India, The Hindu, Prajavani, KannadaPrabha and was given prime importance as well. Here is the entire press release content for your consumption:

It is befitting that a Century Old institution is getting autonomous status and the alumni of the college are elated about it and are looking forward to be part of this new journey.

University Visvesvaraya College of Engineering - the first in the state and fifth in the country, which was established by BharatRatna Sir M V himself, with the blessings of Shri Nalwadi Krishnaraja Wodeyar, is all set to become an autonomous institution after the State Govt passed the UVCE Act -2021 recently. The UVCE Graduates Association thanked the Govt of Karnataka, Basavaraj Bommai, Hon'ble Chief Minister and Dr AshwathaNarayan, Hon'ble Minister of Higher Education for fulfilling this decade long demand.

UVCE Act-2021 declares and constitutes University Visvesvaraya College of Engineering as University of Visvesvaraya College of Engineering to grant autonomy with a view to empower the Institution to attain standards of global excellence in engineering and allied areas of knowledge. This Bill proposes to model UVCE on the lines of Indian Institutes of Technology, Indian Institutes of Management and other Institutions of National Importance.

Dr VK Aatre, alumnus of UVCE from 1961 Electrical batch and PadmaVibhushan, ex Scientific Advisor to the Defence Ministry said "We had some of the best faculty, like Prof BR Narayan Iyengar at UVCE during our time. After 80s, UVCE lost its sheen due to various reasons, one of them being Private Colleges being given more importance. I wish that the Govt decides to support UVCE in all aspects and the alumni is always here to extend their goodwill. Building a campus is needed for the UVCE students to submerge with ideas. Some of the alumni from UVCE have achieved and excelled in their fields leaving a mark around the world."

He also added "We request the Government to give complete freedom and financial support to develop a revamped curriculum, an empowered faculty, acquire latest lab equipment, and work towards greater collaborations with industry and foreign universities for boosting research and promote entrepreneurship".

Major General Neelakantappa, alumnus from 1962 Electrical batch and President of UVCE Graduates Association thanked the Government and said "We thank the Karnataka Govt, Basavaraj Bommai, Hon'ble Chief Minister; Dr C N Ashwathnarayan, Hon'ble Minister for Higher Education; concerned officials and the Special Committee Members for taking it up and making it a reality. UVCE Graduates Association would like to mention that this is the right time for the alumni to come together and give back to our alma-mater. From UVCEGA, we are planning to create a platform for everyone interested to join hands."

He added "We will need a dynamic, capable leadership who can lay a strong foundation for the coming years. So, we urge that the First Director who will be appointed by the State Govt to be an academician/ administrator from IIT/IISc background who can pave a roadmap for excellence. At this point, from UVCEGA, we would like to assure the State Government that entire alumni community will be an active part and provide our complete support to you in this matter."

UVCE Graduates Association is building a strong alumni network and with around 1000 registered Life-time members, it is aiming to support various initiatives at UVCE. Already an R&D Lab with equipment worth 10Lakhs has been donated and Scholarships worth of Rs.10Lakhs are being awarded to students shortly for the current year.

GovindLakshman, alumnus of 1971 Mechanical batch and USA based businessman mentioned that “UVCE alumni across the globe, especially from US are interested to contribute towards the development of our alma-mater. I think the Mechanical Department desperately needs a new building with lab equipment and we urge the Govt to take immediate action on this. Once the autonomous status is formalized, alumni can work with the college authorities to reach greater status and get recognized by Central Govt as ‘Institute of Eminence’ as announced by the Prime Minister couple of years back.”

Srikanth, alumnus of 1993 Electronics batch and a Senior Director in one of the leading MNCs and active member of UVCEGA said “Me and many people like me are proud of the fact that we are from UVCE and part of its legacy. We intend to keep that flag flying high for the future generations. From UVCE Graduates Association, we have series of plans to support the development of the college and we hope more alumni will join hands. We will be organizing an event exclusively for the alumni shortly and drive pledging for the alma-mater. During the course of next 2-3 years, we intend to raise funds worth of 20-30 Crores for the all-round development of the institution from the alumni community and well-wishers of UVCE.”

Highlighting the fact on alumni, he mentioned that “There are 3 PadmaVibhushans, 1 PadmaBhushans and 3 Padmashris in the UVCE Hall of Fame, the stellar list also includes alumni who was part of the team which won the Nobel Peace Prize; alumni who have served in Army, Navy, Airforce at highest ranks; alumni who have led and headed projects and organizations of national importance both in Private & Public sectors; alumni who are in fore front of leading-edge research & technology and heading top universities in the world.”




