

... I recently had occasion to consider how many important sections or divisions there were in the present day engineering profession. I found that at least 20 branches of engineering were receiving attention at the present time. The more important of these are:-

Civil Engineering

Mechanical Engineering

Electrical Engineering

Hydro-Electric Engineering

Marine Engineering

Mining Engineering

Sanitary Engineering


Power Engineering

Topographical Engineering

Chemical Engineering

The newly developing Nuclear Engineering.

We have a large population and the country is backward ion industries. There is an enormous amount of work to be done. Business public are keen on it. At the present time, very large sums of money are spent both by the Government and the public on the purchase of automobiles, aircraft, many kinds of machines like locomotives and other machinery.
