

STORY ABOUT MILAGRO

I would like to clarify that MILAGRO was actually started in 1994.

Praveen Moorthy (who is copied on this email) and myself along with a few others used to attend inter collegiate fests in early 1994 and wanted UVCE to have a festival of its own. The thought was daunting as we were still in the 4th semester and were not sure if UVCE could attract the crowd as seen in other colleges. I have to say it surely was an arduous process trying to get sponsors.

The idea started taking shape and Shashank Hedge who was the President in 1994 got involved as well. He was instrumental as well in making the first Milagro happen.

So here are a few interesting snippets from the first Milagro in 1994. It was a 2 day festival.

- (i) We were desperate for any kind of sponsorship. I remember roaming around the industrial belt of Peenya asking establishments which were basically nothing but 4 walls with a tin roof for sponsorship.
- (ii) We intended to have a tech fair on the first day (Rs.5000 per stall) and approached many companies, but none were interested. Praveen and myself were given an earful from a Cranes Software guy for not being really clear about the focus of the tech fair. In the end though, they did take a stall and sadly enough, they were the only ones.
- (iii) Pepsi agreed to sponsor the rock show on the 2nd day of the festival, but backed away at the last minute. Praveen and myself camped out at the Pepsi office for a few hours until we got a cheque for Rs.50,000. I still remember riding through the rain with Pepsi banners wrapped all around us.
- (iv) The rock show on the 2nd day was by a trash metal group called 'Warden'. Some of Warden's members went on to form 'Millenium'. The rock show was a huge success and laid the initial foundation of MIlagro I suppose.

The second Milagro in 1995 was relatively easy and was a 3 day festival.

The third Milagro in 1996 was the year we were passing out. Praveen Moorthy became the President and did a fantastic job of seeing the festival through. Hero Honda was the main sponsor, but they also backed out torwards the end. The group of about 20-30 students went to the Hero Honda office on M.G.Road and staged a protest. Finally they relented and provided sponsorship. Millenium was the main attraction for the rock show on the 3rd and final day.

There were a lot of folks involved right from the beginning, who without their contributions, Milagro would not exist. If I start naming them, I fear that I would leave someone out.

Nonetheless, MIlagro was one of life's lessons that I carry with me till this day, that nothing is impossible. We were able to start something that has grown so monumental and left an indelible mark in UVCE's history.

Praveen has maintained all the memorabilia from the very first Milagro and am sure would be happy to share them, to include in any future newsletters.

I thought that this piece of history needed to be presented accurately for present and future UVCEians going forwards.

All we were worried about was to find enough participants and audience for each of those events. And I proudly say that the events we came up with had a huge acceptance levels with the crowd and were well received.

The next big thing (I mean Bigggg thing) was the T-shirt aspect. This always takes the centre-stage in every fest across UVCE. Lot of people, unheard until then, start showing their prowess of bagging the contract and pacifying each of them to make sure we got the best deals for the t-shirt at the same time keeping the flock together was an education that will last longer.

Don't destroy UVCE's legacy, pleads scientist

Former chairman of Atomic Energy Commission, MR Srinivasan, said merging University Visvesvaraya College of Engineering (UVCE) with Visvesvaraya Technological University would "obliterate" the memory of an institute started by Sir M Visvesvaraya.

He was speaking at the 47th convocation of Bangalore University (BU) on Thursday. He said there were reports that BU might be bifurcated or trifurcated and that UVCE might me made a part of VTU. He said UVCE had a legacy of its own and merging it with VTU would obliterate the memory of an institute that has produced a galaxy of eminent engineers. He said that at UVCE's reunion in January 2011, the alumni had expressed the view that a new institute of engineering and science should be set up in Muddenahalli, the birthplace of Visvesvaraya.

"I feel envious when I look at universities like Anna University, which have been built on an early legacy," he said.

Further, Srinivasan lauded BU vice-chancellor N Prabhu Dev for his "great work" towards improving the system of education. He said Dev was taking a lot of load on himself and had introduced exam reforms, eliminated malpractices and tried to restore the integrity in administration. He appealed to the state government to help the V-C and his colleagues in restoring the glory of Central College and UVCE and enable them make BU one of the top universities in the country.

Political hindrance

The former chairman of atomic energy commission said the comprehensive report of the task force on education stated that universities in Karnataka enjoyed little autonomy and were subject to constant political and bureaucratic interference, which hampers the initiatives taken by the V-C.

He said it was strongly recommended to keep politicians out of university syndicates, besides setting up a state council for higher education, comprising experts in the field of education.

He said the current set up promoted standardisation, at the cost of innovation.


In this country, at the present time, equipment for practical work of this kind is most necessary. Education should be developed on lines which will best serve her immediate purpose. Routine imitations of even the best countries will not help us so long as the majority of our countrymen remain illiterate and the equipment of the educational institutions happen to be poor.


A highly practical enterprise and superior quality of every kind of work in the country, encouragement from both Government and leading public businessmen is required.

People who show enterprise by starting big works and giving employment to hundreds of workers should be specially encouraged by Government. The employment opportunities of the many depend upon the willingness of the few to take risks.

Western countries have got on well because their Governments encourage enterprise. In India on the other hand, there is too much control exercised and depression created, particularly by the threat of nationalization.

In order that work of good quality may thrive, Government should give encouragement in the shape of grants, rewards, subsidies, remission of taxes and credit facilities, according to the special circumstances of each case.





Government are projecting a Second Five-Year Plan from 1956-1961, the capital expenditure envisaged being of the order of Rs. 5,000 to 5,500 crores.

It is gratifying to learn that special attention will be paid to the development of industries in this Plan.

The experience of the working of the First Five-Year Plan suggests that there is necessity for the adoption of a stricter system of administration and supervision of the operation under the Plan.

We have to remember that works have to be carried on with a majority of illiterate workers and there are bad traditions. These traditions added to illiteracy of workers will always give trouble in long term Plans. The methods of operation have to be changed according to the present circumstances of the country.

A method which is considered suitable is as follows:-

- (1) Before beginning operation in any particular year, a separate one-year plan should be prepared based on the Five-Year Plan. This should be done for each of the five years of the Plan according to the precise conditions of progress of works at the beginning of each year.
- (2) The officers and contractors employed on the works should be asked to go into the details of projects sought to be entrusted to them and satisfy themselves that the estimated cost and time provided are reasonable.

There should be understanding of the precise progress to be attained from quarter to quarter.

(3)After a work is put into operation in the year, inspection should be made at the end of each quarter year by Scrutiny Committee consisting of three persons of known probity and capacity maintained for the purpose.

If the work is satisfactory, the same staff may be continued.
